Some Part I subjects have a competitive entry due to limited space. You should indicate in your Supplementary Application Questionnaire (SAQ) whether your interests lie broadly in biological or physical sciences. The choice isn’t absolute, and many students change direction before they start or as they progress.

Plauss’s treatise stood at the beginning of a renewed wave of scholarship regarding Kant’s Metaphysical Foundations of Natural Science (MF).
